



## WINE MENU

### WHITE WINES

**Stone Cellars Chardonnay**, California

Solid presence of stone fruit with a soft, buttery finish.

**Chateau St. Jean Chardonnay**, California

Classic Sonoma chardonnay with strong notes of pear balanced by lemon & hazelnut.

**Beringer Pinot Grigio**, California

Crisp burst of citrus with a sharp, clean finish.

**Clifford Bay Sauvignon Blanc**, New Zealand

Peach and citrus at the front leading to a quick dry finish.

**Blufeld Reisling**, Germany

Traditional Mosel with floral and stone fruit flavors that linger sweet and long.

**Beringer White Zinfandel**, California

Crisp light blush with hints of strawberry, melon and nutmeg.

### RED WINES

**Stone Cellars Cabernet**, California

Medium body of plum and berries rounded off with notes of chocolate and smoke.

**Chateau St. Jean Cabernet**, California

Full-flavored blackberry and a touch of spice into a smooth end.

**Stone Cellars Merlot**, California

Rich fruit forward cleansed by medium tannins.

**Chateau St. Jean Merlot**, California

Rich plum and tart cherry balanced with mild tannins.

**Rascal Pinot Noir**, Oregon

Big burst of red fruits and herbal undertones with a clean toasty finish.

**Dona Paula Malbec**, Argentina

Medium earthy spice rounds out with berries and smoke.





## SPIRITS MENU

### IRISH WHISKEY

**Jameson** The most famous Irish whiskey has a smooth blend of vanilla, toasted wood and nuts from its two step aging process.

**Bushmills** The flagship of the oldest distillery in Ireland gives a flavor of vanilla and oak.

**Tullemore Dew** This straight-forward blend was first distilled in 1829. It has a bit of medium-sweet honey and a slight burn to the finish.

**Michael Collins** Distilled only twice, this blend delivers a hint of smoke similar to a Scotch.

**Irishman** A little bit of spice kicks up through the vanilla and dried fruit. 70% malt gives it a smooth, mellow finish.

**Bushmills Black Bush** Notes of caramel and toasted cereal combined with sherry casking and 85% malt make this one of the smoothest sipping whiskeys around.

**Bushmills 10yr** Ten years in American oak, this single malt has flavors of chocolate, vanilla and toasted wood.

**Jameson 12yr** Vanilla, caramel, orange zest, cinnamon and black tea are all present in this complex blend. A wonderful intro to higher end Irish quaffs.

### SINGLE MALT SCOTCH WHISKY

**Balvenie 12yr** This "double wood" Speyside malt starts mellow and nutty and gives way to citrus notes. The wood flavor comes last and lingers long.

**Dalwhinnie 15yr** A Highland malt with cedar and grassy flavors followed by a mild smoke.

**Glenfiddich 12yr** A very light whisky from Speyside with notes of buttery almonds.

**Glenlivet 12yr** Very well-balanced Speyside with caramel and just a bit of peat smoke.

**Glenlivet 15yr** Speyside whisky with a fruity peach start that gives way to a bitter chocolate finish.

**Glenmorangie 10yr** A deep amber Highland malt with quite a punch and closes out with strong vanilla.

**Redbreast** A single pot still whiskey using partially unmalted barley, this one consistently ranks among the best in the world. Flavors of vanilla, heather and honey round out the malt.

**Connemara** A peated, single malt aged in bourbon casks, this whiskey is a perfect crossover for Scotch lovers.

**Jameson Gold** A whiskey blend with the tastes of oatmeal cookies and malt sugar with a quick dry finish.

**Bushmills 16yr** Aged first in sherry casks, then in port barrels, this single malt dram has a fruity smooth character from beginning to end.

**Jameson 18yr** Complex and thick with a long finish, this well-aged whiskey gives hints of molasses, apple pie, hazelnut and dried fruit.

**Bushmills 1608** Released to commemorate the 400th anniversary of Bushmills, a crystallized malt unleashes a toffee-like smoothness and warm tastes of vanilla and dried fruit. Sip it slow because when it's gone...it's gone.

**Midleton Very Rare** Only 50 casks are released each year, this blend of 12-25 yr. whiskeys has notes of peach and caramel.

**Jameson Vintage** One of the best spirits in the world. It is a blend of 20-23 yr old whiskeys that offers up a taste of wonderment.

**Lagavulin 16yr** This is what Islay is all about...big smoke flavor with hints of nuts and sandalwood.

**Laphroaig 10yr** Islay malt with hints of earth sea water and smoke moving towards a peppery finish.

**Macallan 10yr** A relatively sweet Speyside with hints of peach, pear and flora.

**Macallan 12yr** Sherry casking brings a sweet fruitiness to this Speyside classic.

**Macallan 18yr** An extra few years in the sherry cask give this whisky an immense character of leather and smoke. One of the best around.

**Oban 14yr** A Highland malt with a quick punch that mellows into a floral and fruity finish.
